An open log fire will cheer you during winter and the activities in the surrounding area will keep you busy all year round no matter what your interests are.



The Lodge is available to anyone but preference is given to education groups. Edrom provides an ideal setting for groups studying history, art and photography, as well as geology, marine biology and many other natural sciences.

Edrom Lodge is a 100-year-old Heritage Listed mansion with dormitory style accommodation for up to 68 people. Situated across the bay from Eden, with your own private beach and 20 acres of private gardens and rainforest, makes it suitable for large university and school groups, community groups, family holidays, weddings or business functions.

You will need to bring your own sleeping bags or blankets and linen, food and toiletries. All other facilities are provided including cooking, refrigeration, washing and ironing facilities. Education groups may request our catering service as an inclusive package.
